Saint Andrew Christmas Novena



Each year on the last day of November, the Church celebrates the feast of the Apostle, Saint Andrew. In the *Gospel according to Saint John,* Saint Andrew responds to Jesus's call and then does Something more:

"He first found his own brother Simon and told him, "We have found the Messiah" (which is Translated Anointed). Then he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon, the son of John; you will be called Cephas" (which is translated (Peter)." (John 1:41-42)

Over the years, November 30 has marked the start of The "Saint Andrew Novena," a prayer offered reverently and devoutly 15 times each day until Christmas. Like all prayer that is a grace of the Holy Spirit, may each of us be drawn to a deeper Awareness of Jesus' presence.

Ministry Corner Service

Contemplating how to intertwine this day in which we honor Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, with ministry became clear when listening to Fr. Mitch Pacwa's homily (EWTN) for this past Wednesday. Jesus shares a parable in the Gospel of Luke that deals with how three servants handled what was given to them by their master. They did not earn it, nor did they do anything to deserve it, but they were entrusted with it. The first two servants invested what was given to them, their investments grew, and the master was pleased. The third servant, because he was fearful, did nothing. The master was, of course, not pleased. When pondering this Gospel, do we relate this to what we do with that which we have been given by God? Our innate talents, abilities, skills, etc., are not something that we obtained on our own, but something upon which we can improve through work. But then what do we do? Do we offer up to Him what has been given to us? On this day in which we honor Christ the King, think about how we can best serve Him through the various ministries in our parish. Can we offer our time, talent, and/or treasure for His Kingdom? Can we lay aside any fear that we might have to stand up for the sanctity of life, visit prisoners, help with fundraisers, take part in the music ministry, join our Knights of Columbus, or simply call the parish office and ask how we can be of help?
