

Dear Parish Family,



I have often said that I find the most neglected and forgotten characteristic of God is His humility. We all know and often repeat that He is omnipresent, omniscient, and all powerful. We know that He is a God of justice and mercy. And yet He condescends to us. He compassionately bends down very low in order to raise us up. He is great, yet He does not use His greatness to condemn us. Rather in His meekness and humility, He calls us to Himself that we might "learn from Him".

St. John Chrysostom reminds us that "God is humble, and we are proud! The judge is gentle; the criminal arrogant! The potter speaks in lowered voice; the clay discourses in the tones of a king! Our Master carries a whip not to wound, but to heal us."

Let us reflect, then, on the incredible humility of our God and His indescribable kindness. He even reaches down from the Cross of His Crucified Son to lift us up. So, I often remind myself, that when He calls us to humility, when He calls us to set aside our human pride, it is in imitation of this basic aspect of His nature. In fact, when we humble ourselves and pray, we are participating in His Divine Nature.

What wonderful words of comfort we hear this weekend from our Lord Jesus. Maybe it is the comfort you need this very moment when much of the world seems to be in turmoil. Perhaps if we view our current difficulties through the eyes of Divine Humility we can set aside not only our pride, but our angst and our despair. For who could not be filled with joy and hope when walking with a Lord so gentle and loving.

Jesus meek and humble of heart, make my heart like unto Thine.

Notice Regarding Reporting Sexual Abuse of a Minor

It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-Hour Child Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at <u>www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis</u>. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.
