

From the Pastor's Desk



Dear Parish Family & Friends,

If there was ever a set of readings specifically designed to lift us up out of our doldrums, the readings of the second week of Advent would certainly qualify. We hear words of comfort and kindness, hope and salvation. The Psalmist tells us that "kindness and truth shall meet; justice and peace

shall kiss". We are even called beloved by Saint Paul.

This all culminates with the rather striking figure of John the Baptist calling us to prepare the way of the Lord. Just thinking about his camel hair clothing makes me itch. I wonder if some people were dissuaded from hearing the message because of the locust eating figure proclaiming all these wonders. Though he might have been initially a bit scary, I would have been inspired with his humility. He said, "One mightier than I is coming after me." There is something so compelling about John the Baptist as he quotes Isaiah the prophet, "Prepare the way of the Lord."

This call, first given to the contemporaries of Jesus, spans the centuries and touches this heart with a desire to "prepare". And here is the miracle, not only do we receive the call and motivation to prepare for the Lord's coming, He, Jesus, is doing a bit of His own preparing. While we are called to make the path straight, Jesus is busy about smoothing out our rough places. He is changing our disorderly ways into level paths, creating in us an even and unimpeded road. So, let us prepare, and let us let Him do the rest. For me with my imperfections this is a major construction project. I only have to recall the deep valleys and perilous pits of my life before I put my faith in Jesus to see how masterfully He works in our world and in our human hearts when we cooperate with Him.

One of the Church Fathers has written that, "if Christ did not come to your soul, of what use would His historical coming in the flesh be to you? Let us pray that each day we may experience His coming!" Amen!


