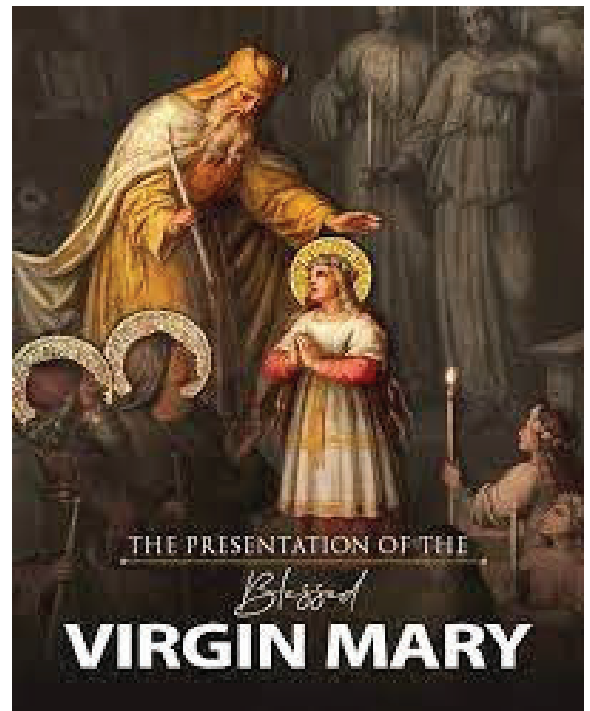

Thanksgiving

"In all created things discern the providence and wisdom of God, and in all things give Him thanks" (St. Teresa of Avila). Thanksgiving is lost in the shuffle at times, especially when there is so much discord all around us (and Christmas seems to begin in July)!
