Dear Parish Family,

As we continue to move through Lent, symbolically our time with Jesus in the desert, we may already be struggling with our resolve to

fast, pray and give alms. We, especially in our great country, are so accustomed to immediately satisfying all our needs and desires. Are you having a rough day—go ahead and grab that cookie, beer or whatever distraction we find helps us. If we feel a pang of hunger, we are often too quick to forget the call to fast. Sometimes, without even thinking we drive through McDonalds or go to the fridge and down a burger or a ham and cheese sandwich even though we are called to abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent.

One of the purposes for our Lenten observances is to help us observe what we may take for granted. The intent is not to discourage us, but to make us more aware of the blessings of God, and to remind us that others suffer hunger and poverty each day without even the benefit of knowing that our Lord Jesus is there to comfort and aid them in their times of need. In addition to reminding us to be grateful, we are also called to help those in need with our sustenance and prayers. I love the fact that this Sunday we read about the mountain top experience the disciples had when Jesus was Transfigured before them.

Jesus took them up onto the mountain in order to show them His kingship before they witnessed His passion, to let them see His mighty power before they watched His death, to reveal His glory to them before they beheld His humiliation. The Lord takes us to that scene that we may not become discouraged. We are given this shared experience of witnessing to the divinity of Christ, especially when our human nature fails us so very often. We are given a glimpse of the divinity of Christ and a "preview" of the glory to come—His and ours.
