Dear Parish Family and Friends,

Jesus changed Simon into Peter and Saul into Paul. He not only gave them new names. He made Peter the Rock, the first Pope of the Catholic Church. He made Paul an Apostle to the nations. I recently read a homily by St. Chrysostom in which he stated, "Peter fell. Paul

was thrown to the ground. Both were made weak that they might rise again strong." I wonder what He is making of us?

Many people, myself included, can become discouraged as they/we strive for the Christian perfection to which we are called. We receive, as we celebrate the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, a glorious reminder that when we rely on our own strength we are prideful and may fall into apostacy as Peter did when he denied the Lord. When we reject the words of Sacred Scripture, choosing worldly wisdom, or worse yet our own opinions, over Divine Wisdom, we are already blinded. We recognize this is for the very reason that we might not surrender to discouragement, but surrender to God. I have a priest friend who often says when asked what God's Will is for our lives, "The Sacrament of Confession is the Divine Will." Rather than considering Confession/Penance/Reconciliation a chore or an unpleasant task which we undertake when we "have to," God uses that Sacrament to lift us up from the mire of our sin as He lifted up the two Saints we honor today.

Whatever He is making of each of us with our individual talents and resources, it is a cause for rejoicing. You may not become a St. Peter or a St. Paul, but He is making you a Saint You.
