

I enjoyed the time I spent with our teens and young adults last Sunday. They had some interesting questions which I tried to answer. I hope we can continue these "chats with Fr. Mike". I don't get to spend much time with our teens, so this is really important to me.

There is just so much to be thankful for. I just had this experience today in the parking lot at Weis. As I was walking to my car a lady was loudly calling out, "Sir, sir." I'm not very accustomed to being call sir, so I kept walking, but the third time she said, "Sir", I decided to turn around and make sure everything was alright with her. She got this big look of relief on her face and asked if I was the Pastor at that Church. I told her I was the Pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes. She said she thought that was me. To make this long story a bit shorter, she said she had met me at Mass, and she was praying that God would send someone to help her, and that she had no one to turn to. Through her tears she told me her situation and asked for prayers. We prayed right there in the parking lot. Afterwards she told me that she knew she could now handle the situation since God sent me to pray with her. It was truly a graced moment.

Who do you take your troubles to? Jesus heard Simon's prayer for his sick mother-in-law and the fever left her. There is no trouble He will not face with us and for us. Put your trust in Him. When Simon's mother-in-law is cured, she does what Jesus Himself does. She serves those in need. She becomes a disciple. Jesus heard the prayers of that poor lady who approached me, and she got the strength to do what she had to do, which included helping her mother through a difficult time.

Jesus hears our prayers. We may not always receive a physical healing, but we can be sure that each time we come to Him He offers us spiritual healing and strength. Wellbeing of spirit involves a willingness to serve, while spiritual sickness means that I am concerned only about myself. As we pray for our various concerns, for ourselves and others, let us ask the Lord to make us truly well. Ask yourself, "What do I need from Jesus?" Are you just a spectator in the scene, or are you fighting to get close to Him? His presence brings wholeness – do you need that? People become more alive – do you need that? Simon's mother-in-law gets the energy to serve – do you need that? Let it not be true that 'everyone is searching for Him' - except you.




