

Dear Parish Family and Friends,

We now know that the glorification of Jesus took place when He rose from the dead and ascended into Heaven, but all was not yet accomplished. The Holy Spirit still had to be given; the One who made the promise had to send Him. This is precisely what occurred at Pentecost.

Pentecost is a day of gifts. Jesus gave His apostles, and now gives to each of us, gifts the likes of which the world had never known. The event was marked with glorious manifestations:

Suddenly a sound came from heaven like the rush of a mighty wind, and there appeared to them tongues like fire which separated and came to rest on each one of them. (Acts2:2)

We often refer to Pentecost as the birthday of the Church. I wonder if the source of using candles on our birthday cakes stems from the tongues of fire on that spectacular celebration of new birth in Christ by the Holy Spirit. Also, part of any birthday celebration includes gift giving. God, in His

magnificent generosity gave the everlasting gifts of peace, joy, love and power to His disciples. I can't help but recall the seven gifts bestowed on our young people who received the Sacrament of

Confirmation earlier this month: wisdom, understanding, knowledge, right judgement, courage, reverence and wonder and awe. These are everlasting gifts which will not rust or fade. Nor will they fall out of fashion. It is these gifts from the Blessed Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, that make us one and keeps us free.

If you yourselves are established in the unity of faith and the love of Christ Jesus, you have the Holy Spirit, and nothing can separate you from the Church of Christ, the Catholic Faith which speaks in the language of every nation of the world. As St. Augustine wrote, "What discord had scattered, love was to gather together." Keep this day with joy. Celebrate it in freedom of spirit. For what was promised from of old has been given to you!
