Dear Parish Family and Friends,

This weekend, the Second Sunday of Advent, Matthew records part of John the Baptist's sermon. It is a blistering sermon calling for repentance. It is so blistering that at one point he calls the Pharisees and Sadducees a "brood of vipers". I imagine that would constitute quite a bit more than a micro-aggression these days! And yet...might it not be something we need to hear? Yours truly, included.

Not that we are anything like a brood of vipers, but we all are involved in that process of repenting. I have a priest friend who says that Confession is not only a Sacrament, but the Divine Will of God. Confession and repentance are His Will for us. So these words from John the Baptist are timely and well taken as we light the Candle of Peace on our Advent wreath. There is no peace without Christ, and there is no relationship with Christ Jesus without repentance. Here is something I find quite interesting. The Lord Jesus (Matthew 4:17) began His preaching of the Gospel with the very same words with which John the Baptist began his preaching (Matthew 3:2), "Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand."

Thus endeth the sermon. :-) Thus beginneth and "continueth" a life of joy and glory in Christ.
