I have, from time to time, had conversations with people who sincerely feel that Catholics should not celebrate the 4th of July because it is a secular holiday. Although I would certainly not put any holiday above our Holy Days, I do think it is a good thing to celebrate and remember all that God has given us as Americans. As we commemorate the "birthday" of the United States with our fireworks, cookouts, family gatherings and perhaps by displaying an American flag, we can also include gratitude to God.


