



Dear Parishioners and Friends,

This fifth Sunday of Lent we read that some Greeks came up to Philip and made the request, "Sir, we would like to see Jesus." We learn from our Lord's response that they, and we, are to find Him in the grain of wheat that falls to the ground and dies. This response of Jesus points us to a reality which forms the foundation of our Catholic faith and our life with

reality which forms the foundation of our Catholic faith and our life wi Jesus. Where do we, who ardently long to see Jesus, find Him?

This may seem like a strange way to begin our search for Jesus, but we must find Him as He really is. He really is willing to die for our sins, and like a grain of wheat in the ground, once He is planted in our hearts He sprouts up. The humility of Jesus is the basis of the New Covenant of love and forgiveness He is establishing with us.

In addition, if we should like to see Jesus we need to look for the fallen grains of wheat around us. St. Mother Theresa taught us by her extraordinary example that Jesus is to be found in the "poorest of the poor". If we wish to see Him, we must be willing to look for those who are loosing their lives—the victims of poverty, abuse, and violence as well as the lonely, the depressed and the neglected.

We have to have written, or perhaps planted in keeping with the grain of wheat theme, in our hearts that we are God's people who aspire to be like Christ in transforming the darkness of the world's pain into the Joy of Easter.

Do you, as the Greeks in the Gospel reading this weekend wish to see Jesus? Then become one of His little grains of wheat and offer your heart, your life and your will to Him. And glory of glories, you will begin to find Him in creation, in others and in your hearts from this day and unto eternity.




