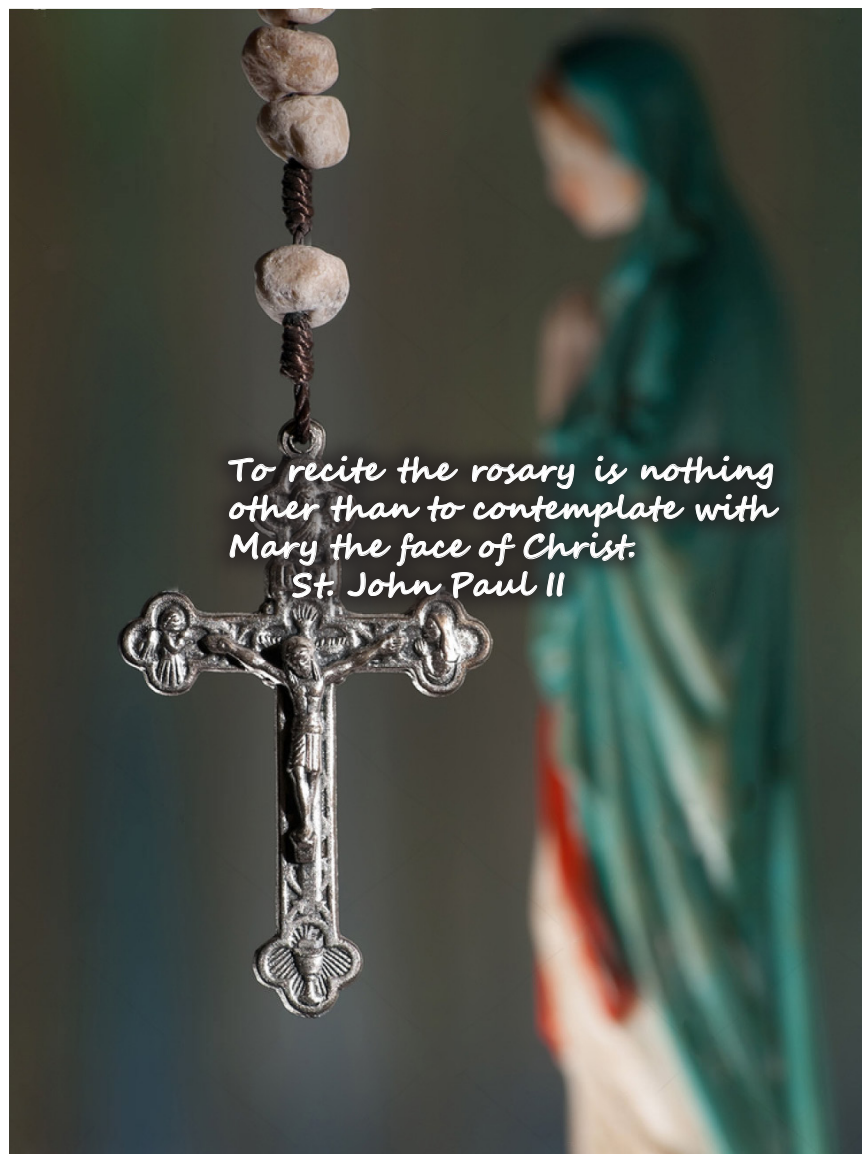

It is the telling of 16 "showings" or visions that Julian received in the 1370's. This book is one of the earliest texts written by a woman in the English language. Her writings explore themes of God's Love and human suffering. It is a shorter book which they expect to complete by the end of the year.
